
INVESTING IN THE COMMUNITY: Reservoir Park Basketball Court Mural

As the 75th anniversary of the credit union's founding approached late last year, Fort Financial wanted to mark the occasion by giving back to the community in a meaningful way.

The credit union partnered with Fort Wayne Parks and Recreation to resurface and enhance two basketball courts in Ivan Lebamoff Reservoir Park near downtown Fort Wayne this summer.

The courts feature a unique mural installed by local artist Andre Portee to pay homage to the neighborhood. The project also included new backboards, painted rims and new benches.

The court renovation symbolizes our steadfast commitment to serving Fort Wayne and the surrounding area then, now, and well into the future.
