Who is eligible?

 year and will be considered full-time status. NOTE: The student must be in the
 upper 25% of their high school graduating class.
- Students currently attending or accepted to an accredited college or university who have a full-time student status.
- Students must hold a membership account with Fort Financial Credit Union in their name and be in good standing.
- Student and person(s) responsible for their support must be in good member standing with Fort Financial Credit Union.

What type of things are considered in the selection process?

The Scholarship Committee looks for an overall level of high achievement in the areas of academics and community involvement. In addition, the committee will consider other aspects including evidence of high quality character, initiative, integrity, concern for others, and financial need.

How do I apply?

If you are a member in good standing of Fort Financial Credit Union, you may apply.
